## THE VEEVA OPPORTUNITY

#### Customer Success driven

- Veeva is disruptive and successfully replacing legacy systems
- This is true in Clinical, Regulatory, Quality, soon Safety

#### Meanwhile...

Veeva has application-specific archive solutions (ie: Submissions Archive) but not an overarching archive

# Customer is looking for a solution

- According to Gartner up to 80 % of data in operational applications is inactive
- Migrate active data/content into Veeva
- Ideally, archive all/some of legacy system (inactive) into Veeva
  - Access/Security through the same Veeva interface
  - Put into a Veeva archive area
  - Lower overall cost of moving data/content to Veeva



#### **CUSTOMER EXAMPLES**

- Customer 1 Legacy QMS to Veeva POC
- Customer 2 Qumas/DCTM to Veeva POC
- Customer 3 Lotus Notes to Vault POC
- Customer 4 Reducing migration scope from 8m to 2m
  - Current Vault customers
  - Have data/documents that need to be archived
  - No cohesive archive strategy
    - Have been discussing archive strategy for multiple years
  - Contact your Veeva account executive for cost/license questions
    - Clinical data should be archived to Clinical Vault, Quality data should be archived Quality Vault, etc.
    - Veeva does not want this to be a "dumping ground"




# BENEFITS OF ARCHIVING TO VEEVA

- Same familiar user interface for active and archived data/documents
  - Veeva platform features, such as security, search and reporting are extended to the archive solution as well
- A single vendor solution, not multiple vendors, for both active and archived data/documents
- Archiving is cost effective up to 60% less expensive when compared to migrations
  - No business-level mappings required of source data or lookup values
  - No extensive configuration in Veeva to store archived data/documents

- Flattened data structures





- Veeva user interface, security and reporting






#### **GXP ARCHIVE MENU**





# **ARCHIVE RECORD SETS**




#### Record sets are used to:

- Control access and security




### ARCHIVE RECORD SET DETAILS






# **ARCHIVED RECORD – STANDARD INFORMATION (1 OF 2)**






# **ARCHIVED RECORD – STANDARD INFORMATION (2 OF 2)**






# **ARCHIVED RECORD – CUSTOM FIELDS**






#### **ARCHIVED RECORD - ATTACHMENTS**
